1.	$\frac{1}{2}$	Shaded parts: 1, Total parts: 2, Fraction: $\frac{1}{2}$
2.	$\frac{1}{3}$	Shaded parts: 1, Total parts: 3, Fraction: $\frac{1}{3}$
3.	$\frac{2}{3}$	Shaded parts: 2, Total parts: 3, Fraction: $\frac{2}{3}$
4.	$\frac{1}{4}$	Shaded parts: 1, Total parts: 4, Fraction: $\frac{1}{4}$
5.	$\frac{3}{4}$	Shaded parts: 3, Total parts: 4, Fraction: $\frac{3}{4}$
6.	$\frac{1}{2}$	one-half = $\frac{1}{2}$
7.	$\frac{3}{4}$	three-fourths = $\frac{3}{4}$
8.	$\frac{2}{3}$	two-thirds = $\frac{2}{3}$
9.	$\frac{1}{4}$	one-fourth = $\frac{1}{4}$
10.	$\frac{5}{6}$	five-sixths = $\frac{5}{6}$
